TRANSFORMATIVE AFFECT STUDENTS MOTIVATION

The feedback consisted four states of Instructional Design Affect on Motivation by (Keller 1983, 1987, 2010) the implementation of PeGASUS. This questionnaire contained 36 questions with 5 point likert scale anchored in completely disagree and completely agree that demonstrated how the learners rated the potential of PeGASUS. They confirmed that PeGASUS framework had a potential to help them to become motivated in the learning process.
